We are happy to introduce the **National Youth Achievement Award (NYAA)** to your son as part of our school's effort to produce a **holistic education program** for all our students.

NYAA is a program seeking to develop and maximize the potential of young people through selfless community service, challenges of adventure, skills development and physical recreation so that they may be **exceptional individuals** who can contribute effectively to society and the nation.

To date, nearly 130,000 young people in Singapore have been motivated to undertake a variety of voluntary and challenging activities in each of four areas, namely Service, Adventurous Journey, Skills and Physical Recreation.

This is a program that could last from 6 – 9 months. Hence we would need your son's commitment and your kind support to motivate your son to accomplish all the challenges mentioned above.

Also, your child will be mostly riding on pre-existing activities to fulfill the award requirements. For example, for adventurous journey criteria, your child can use the Sec 3 camp which he will be attending next year. Hence, no duplication of effort is required.

Upon meeting the various criterions, your son will be presented with the NYAA. In addition, the Ministry of Education awards **2** Co-Curricular Activity bonus points to all students who have achieved the National Youth Achievement Award (Bronze), which can aid in admission to polytechnics and universities.
